Inquests before Mr. Busby. (part).

On Wednesday, the 7th. inst., at Staveley, on the body of James Salesbury (or Salisbury), of Staveley, colliery labourer, aged 19 years. On the 2nd. inst. deceased was working in the Hollingwood coalpit, belonging to R. Barrow, Esq., when a piece of coal weighing eight or nine hundredweights, fell upon deceased. He was taken from under the coal directly, but died in a few minutes. Verdict, "Accidental death".
