Ingleton Colliery

It is gratifying to announce that Mr E. Danson, Manager of the Ingleton Colliery, recently carried on by the late Mr William Bracewell, has been successful in obtaining the Royalty for coal mining in the Ingleton District, and that the sinking of new shafts will shortly be commenced. The stoppage of Wilson Wood Colliery where about 150 men and boys were employed, told a serious tale in Ingleton and caused a large number of men to flee to other places in search of employment. Fortunately another kind of work (quarrying) was commenced by Mr Hewitson about the same time, which gave employment to many who did not wish to leave.
